## My Mother - My Role Model

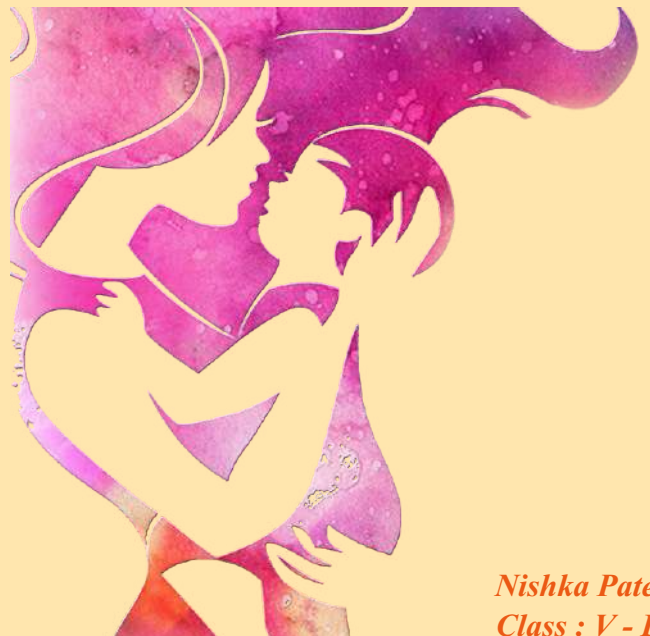

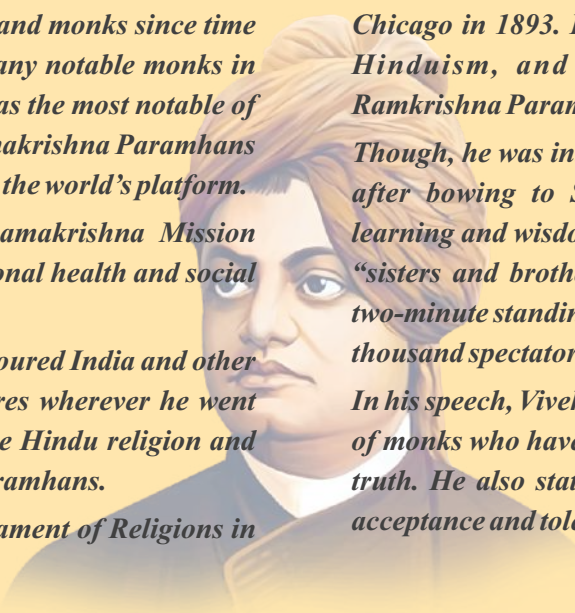
*He also attended the World Parliament of Religions in*

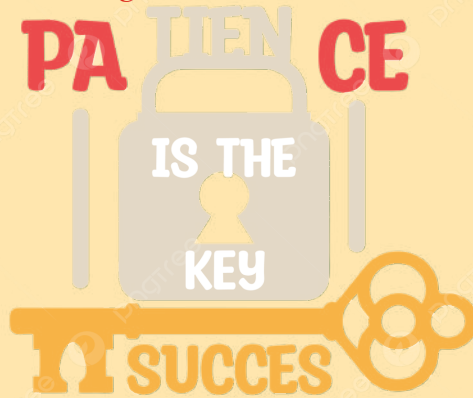

## What Makes a True Leader

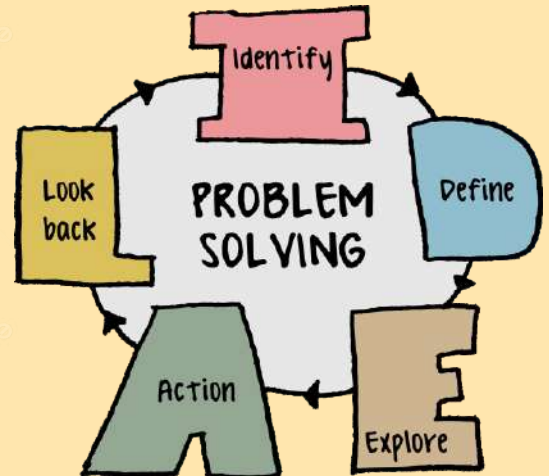

### INDIA'S SIZE AND ECONOMIC STRENGTH

India is the most populous country in the world (1.43 billion) according to the World Population Prospects 2023. A comparison of the ratio of India's working-age population (WAP) (as defined as 15 - 64 years) population to the total population with that of other countries, China, Brazil, the USA, and Japan, shows that India stands at an advantageous position. The WAP of these countries has started declining.

Currently, India is the third largest economy in the world in terms of purchasing power parity, with a share of 7 per cent of global GDP (after China 18 and the US 16 per cent). The Indian economy is a world leader in the production of various agricultural commodities. India has emerged as the world's number 1 rice exporter, with more than the combined exports of world Numbers 2 and 3. India has one of the widest manufacturing bases among emerging economies, ranging from the largest producer and exporter of tractors and two-wheelers to among the top 10 exporters of smart phones, cars and spacecraft. In the case of IT, India has come to be known as the back office of the world. (Patra, 2022)

### SPACE DIPLOMACY

Space is now an emerging area for countries to establish their dominance in space. Authority in space technology creates opportunities to build and expand relations as well as achieve national interests. Almost every sector, starting from agriculture to transport, weather department and even urban development, to name a few, now wants satellite data imageries and space technology to draw their future strategy and grow business.

The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) now a part of space exploration folklore around the world's the most credible example of this transformation.
