GENERAL RULES

- **ENGLISH SPEAKING IS COMPULSORY IN THE SCHOOL.**
- Students are expected to respect the property of others. This includes respect for school property. No student should any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the class teacher or to the principal. Students found guilty of damaging school property or disturbing the discipline will be fined/dismissed from the school.
- The is not responsible for goods lost. Students are not allowed to bring valuable articles (expensive watches, fountain pens or mobiles) to the School. No books (other than textbooks or library books), magazines or money, should be brought to the school without the Principal's permission.
- Parents are not allowed to bring their wards to the school if the miss the school bus.
- As far as possible, once a child has come to the school, he/she should be asked to come home on half day leave or leave from any period. In case of on emergency, parents will be asked to personally come and pick up their wards.
- Parents and guardians are not allowed to visit their wards or teachers in the class rooms.
- Report Cards may be withheld owing to Non-payment of Fees.
- Bullying and use of foul language are punishable offences.
- Students should not involve themselves in buying selling or gambling of any kind.
- The School reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- The School will not entertain any application regarding the change of section of any child.
- Students should not wear casual dress and bring gifts on the birthdays.
- Students will not be allowed to change third language and activities during session.
- Leave or absence for more than three days will not be granted unless prior permission is sought for, through a proper application.
- Private tuitions are strictly disallowed.
- Weak students may be asked to stay back for remedial classes.
- Parents are required to maintain a professional distance with the educators of the School. They are not permitted to give gifts or invite them to parties etc.

It is extremely important that the students adhere to the code of conduct laid down by the School. On failing to do so, they will be default with severely.

ASSESSMENT & PROMOTION

NORMS (FOR ALL CLASSES)

- In case a student misses a test he/she will be marked as absent for the same. There will be **NO RETESTS**.
- A student must secure an aggregate of **40%** to qualify for Promotion to the next class.
- A student must secure minimum **40%** marks in all study subjects (English, Hindi, Maths, Social Sciences, Science) for promotion to the next class.
- Students may be given **Conditional Promotion** on the basis of past performance and solely on the discretion of the Principal and subject teachers.
- Average marks will be given based on the overall performance of the student during the Units only in the case of a **MEDICAL REASON** for which a valid Medical Certificate will need to be submitted by parent.
- The School reserves right to remove the student from its rolls if he/she fails twice in the same class.
